LEAVEN is the financial emergency room for people in need.

What does LEAVEN do?

LEAVEN is a community based non-profit organization that provides emergency financial assistance, referrals to other service organizations and limited advocacy and service coordination to help residents of Calumet, Outagamie and northeastern Winnebago counties.

Help provided is typically immediate, short-term and emergency based.

LEAVEN was founded in 1987 by local religious, business and community leaders to address the problems of meeting emergency financial needs of local people. It is a success story that has been built on the community's capacity and willingness to care.

LEAVEN relies on the talents of over 200 volunteers, a small staff and the generosity of donors to fulfill its mission.

What do we help with?

LEAVEN helps with basic human needs, primarily helping people stay in their homes or apartments. We help with rent, mortgage and security deposits.

We help to make sure gas, electric or water services are not shut off or are reconnected.

We also provide gas cards, bus passes, diapers, toiletries and vouchers for clothing and furniture.

LEAVEN helps a variety of people.

Our clients include all ages and various types of households. They are racially and ethnically diverse and are most often employed.

Administrative expenses are kept exceptionally low thanks to many in-kind donations from the community and by utilizing trained volunteers to do the various jobs at LEAVEN.

How can I help LEAVEN?

• Financial

Financial donations from churches, business, individuals and other organizations contribute immensely to our ability to directly assist clients.

• Long-term

Support our endowment funds and planned giving. Our goal is to cover 100% of administrative costs through endowment distributions, freeing up more dollars for direct client assistance.
