

Green Lake Conference Center is a beautiful, special place for conferences, retreats, and vacations.



At ***The Heart of a Leader*** we desire to help each person realize more fully what it means to be an image bearer; to accept and enjoy the unique way God created us as males or females and to be affirmed in our dignity.

We will also consider more deeply how the fall has permeated and affected every part of our humanity; to look more specifically at how sin works itself out in our lives and in the way we live and relate to others.

The course will help to gain a clearer picture of the vision that God has for our lives and His desire to redeem and restore; to experience true hope for healing and lasting change in being transformed more and more into the likeness of Christ and in loving as He loves.

Course Structure

The Heart of a Leader is designed to make disciples at a deeper level of the heart. Discipleship is a radical transformation of how we think, feel and live.

Through a blend of teaching, intense small group interaction and reflective journaling, people are helped to know their design by God, how sin has impacted them and how their story is a part of His redemptive larger story in our world today.

Utilizing the above format, we will journey back through our lives to consider ways we have been wounded, and commitments we've made in response to those painful experiences that contribute to our style of relating.

The Heart of a Leader is designed to be a safe place for pastors, leaders and their spouses to be honest about their stories...every part of it.

A place where we can take deliberate time to do some personal inventory and evaluation of what's really going on inside of us; where we can do what Paul instructed young Timothy to do: "Pay close attention to yourself and your teaching...persevere in these things"....1 Timothy 4:16. We take an honest look at how we relate to those we're in close relationship with and those we lead.

Through a combination of teaching, reflection and small group interaction, God just might use this week to cause your heart to be significantly transformed, resulting in you becoming a more authentic, others-centered and loving leader.

This course is structured to be an intense, focused time of teaching, reflection about one's own life and past, and small group interaction based on that. Teaching time is condensed to illustrate the material you have read and emphasize or clarify the concepts we are learning. Small group time is a critical part of the week, where you will get to know your story better and hear others' stories in a way that reveals wounds and commitments we have made in life that hinder our walk with God and hinder loving others more authentically. The questions are designed to have you apply what you are learning to your own life. Reflection time is designed to allow God to reveal truth and grace to parts of your story/life that have possibly been hidden or unexamined.
